1. Victoria Youth Clinic

FREE Health Care Service for youth 12 to 24 years. You don't need a Care Card but let us know if you want help to apply for one. **All services are confidential.** Bring your Friends! Food is always available so feel free to drop in for something to eat!

A physician, nurse/counsellor and medical office assistant staff the clinic on a part-time basis. The clinic is currently operated at two different sites: James Bay Community Project on Tuesday & Thursday afternoon/evenings and Monday & Wednesday afternoon/evenings in Downtown Victoria. It is a priority for us to be responsive to you about your needs and preferences for accessing health care. We work hard to understand what is unique about your health needs and to tailor the service to overcome the barriers you might experience in accessing care.

3. Cool Aid Community Health Centre (Access Health Centre)

The Cool Aid Medical Clinic was established in 1970, to provide primary health care for people who do not have medical coverage, or who live in the downtown core, many of whom suffer from mental health and addiction illnesses and/or other chronic health problems. The Cool Aid Community Health Centre endeavours to create an environment of trust and mutual respect between the staff and the clients it serves. Through an innovative team-based approach, services at the Centre are designed to reduce the significant barriers facing the downtown population from accessing health services.
